***Blessed and Joy Filled Easter!***

A holy and blessed Easter to you and your loved ones in my own name and the name of the clergy and staff of St. Thomas More Parish!

Today is without doubt the most significant and profound celebration of our year. All other feasts and celebrations both point and bow to the Easter mystery. We have just walked with Jesus through Jerusalem on Palm Sunday to the Upper Room where he instituted the Eucharist and Holy Priesthood then on to the Garden of Gethsemane and to return gloriously to the Father on Easter morning.

Let us be overwhelmed and experience the intense joy that must have entered John, Peter and Mary's hearts when they came to know and believe in the resurrection. In the days in which we live we can so easily be discouraged by events that are happening in our country's life, the Church's struggles and our very own personal relationships. Yet, as Catholics we believe in the constant renewal and redeeming presence of Christ to "make all things new" not just those that already seem to possess the newness.

This Easter morning is special in our parish not only because of the twelve converts to the faith received at the Vigil but also for the unveiling of the new stained glass windows at the chapel. It is interesting that these windows look beautiful only from the inside of the Church and don't look like much at all from the outside (same at St Thomas More!). Only inside the Body of Christ can we see the light shine through the cut and painted glass to speak to us and raise our hearts to the resurrection. Transformed by Christ Jesus in the Eucharist and strengthened by the saints who intercede for us, we go out to the world to let Christ Jesus shine through the way we live our daily lives so others can encounter the Lord.

This is the great Easter commissioning that we have all been given. So, let us go forth with a holy confidence in what the Father has accomplished and what He has redeemed in Christ. This is the mystery we celebrate. When we live, move and have our being in Christ and live in his light (like these windows radiate!) then others will come also to live in the light of Christ's resurrection.

May Christ be our light!
