Catholic Charity Drive Has Begun!

This weekend marks the beginning of our formal Catholic Charity Fund (CCF) campaign. I know some “Bishops Partners” and others have already given to the campaign -- thank you! The CCF is a central way in which the Diocese of Providence runs most of its ministries and outreach. This year’s theme is “works of mercy need a hand”. Our parish has traditionally waited until the Easter season to run our annual charity drive. ***Our goal this year is \$121,000.*** These monies will help the Church continue to reach out to the less fortunate and needy. This past year the Charity Fund Drive has funded outreach to 400 women and families in need, provided parenting workshops for over 100 people and helped over 1000 people ministering to AIDS patients and their families.

In addition, the Charity Fund Drive helps provide spiritual counseling and support for the prisoners and their families at the ACI as well as 8,245 seniors receiving health care, support and services.

Thousands of Rhode Islanders receive support through subsidies for the poor to attend Catholic schools. Many attend youth programs and retreats throughout every part of the state and over 31,000 public school students that are in CCD programs.

As you can see there are too many services that rely on our generosity and charity. The Charity Fund is the most consistent way we as church can reach out and put Christ’s life and resurrection into action.

I want to thank Ann Buffum and Diane DeMichele as well as Jeanne Simeone for their outstanding work in making our drive organized and successful as well as my brother priests Msgr. Halloran and Fr. Henry for their many years of dedication to helping raise awareness of the needs that are met through the donations.

Let’s pray that our drive will be a success this year when there are ever-increasing needs and opportunities to help others in the Lord’s name.
