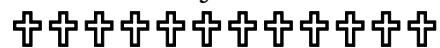

***The Feast of St. Thomas More....who was he?***

Our feast weekend is upon us and I hope you can make every effort to attend, support, pray for and volunteer for the varied activities we have planned. The culmination, of course, is the Mass at St. Thomas More on Sunday June 20<sup>th</sup> at 10 am with Archbishop Edwin O'Brien of Baltimore presiding, followed by our one mile, less-than-one-hour Eucharistic procession around the Pier ending on the courtyard steps!

St. Thomas More's life ended on July 6, 1535 as he was beheaded after an extended imprisonment in the Tower of London. The Church celebrates his feast along with St. John Fisher on June 22<sup>nd</sup>. His most famous last words "I die the king's good servant, but God's first" resonates down through the centuries. In some ways his life, witness and virtue are more needed now in the times and culture in which we live.

Thomas More was an astute lawyer, judge, civil servant and literary scholar. His prayer life (attracted to the ascetical Carthusian spirituality) enabled him to discern the Lord's will in a way that led Thomas to honor Christ Jesus in his private and public life as well as that of his vocation to marriage and family. He was the same disciple of the Lord all the time and everywhere. *He is the saint of conscience.* When Henry the VIII wanted to divorce his wife Catherine and take Anne Boleyn as his wife Thomas could not support this because the Church would not concur. The ensuing development of Henry VIII appointing himself head of the Church of England brought Thomas sadness, concern and eventually treason charges! He lost his lands, his positions, many friends and respect in his time. He claimed he could not betray his conscience. ***So the question remains for us as it did for him...who or what formed his conscience?*** This is as important in our time as it is in any time. As Catholics we believe in Jesus Christ and the authority of the Church in matters regarding faith and morals. Our tradition is rich and full of mercy and truth. St. Thomas More is indeed "a man for all seasons" whose life and death encourages us through the challenges of winter to the promises of spring.

May our prayers, meditation and reflection on his life and witness encourage us to be committed (always with joy and humor as he was) to following Christ and spreading the kingdom of God here in South County for the sake of all. Blessed Feast to all!
