### ***Summer “Catholic” Reading?***

These hot days of summer (and finally a seemingly real summer!) are upon us. Of the many joys of the beach, BBQ’s, parties and picnics one of the pleasures is that of reading. In our technological age a good book remains a means to quiet and peace in our modern world. So, what are we reading? I know we have an active and full parish book club and many of us try to get more reading done in our leisure time. I confess I love bookstores more than buying books online. I think being surrounded by books is better than scanning covers on the internet. Regrettably, I confess that in haste I have bought books that were at airport counters that read like a combination of *People Magazine*, a soap opera and a dash of *Rolling Stone*!

May I propose that this summer we all try to read something rooted in our faith? The possibilities are endless. Sadly, the category “Catholic” in most bookstores today contains many books that are actually in effect “anti-Catholic”. May I make a few suggestions?

Anything by Scott Hahn is a great place to start if we have never read the Catholic genre before. He is a vibrant Catholic convert who is readable, interesting and informative. I especially loved his book, “The Lamb’s Last Supper” about the Book of Revelation and the Mass, which will sure change how we experience the Mass and the Eucharist. He has many other books that are great.

The popular author Anne Rice who wrote vampire novels has come back to her Catholic faith and now her new books are rooted in her Catholicism. Perhaps give her another look.

Looking for witness/adventure based on faith? *With God in Russia* is by Walter Chiszek, SJ who details and shares his life in the prison camp in Russia. Powerful and inspiring. *As is Man of Beatitudes* about Blessed Giorgio Frassati, a testimony of a real modern-day saint in contemporary times.

Pope Benedict has written extensively. Some of his books are very dense and deeply philosophical. Others are written in popular format. I recently enjoyed his book, “The Apostles” that has a brief chapter on each of the Twelve.

Lastly, may I suggest as many of us as possible subscribe to *Catholic Answers*? It is a quarterly magazine that does a simply dynamite job at teaching and explaining simple and complex teachings and practices. I love getting it and reading it. Highly recommended.

And of course....there is always Sacred Scripture. Perhaps read Ecclesiastes or the Book of Wisdom. Let’s read but make some room for faith in these weeks the Lord has blessed us with.
