Dear Parishioners,

After two weeks at St. Thomas More Parish, I realize that I still have not had the opportunity to introduce myself to many of you so please allow me to give you some background on who your new associate pastor is.

I am a native Rhode Islander having been born and lived most of my life in Woonsocket. I attended a public elementary school, Catholic junior high school and graduated from Woonsocket High School. Following my high school graduation, I attended Bryant College and received a Bachelor of Science degree with a major in accounting. I earned my CPA and worked in local CPA firms before joining the corporate tax department at National Grid. While at National Grid, I earned my Master of Science in Taxation from Bryant College Graduate School. All together I worked for 12 years after college before hearing and responding to God's call to be a priest at the age of 33.

I cannot say that the priesthood was something that I thought about my whole life. When I was a teenager, someone told me "You should be a priest" but I didn't want to hear it. When I was working at National Grid, I was happy and truly enjoyed the work I was doing and the people with whom I worked but there was a sense that something was missing. I found myself drawn to Mass and prayer and from that heard God speaking to me as a priest asked in his homily, "What would God have me to do?" Praying about that, I was open to God's call to the priesthood although uncommitted until praying before the Blessed Sacrament during a retreat that the Bishop hosted for men who are discerning and I made the decision to enter. I began the application process and entered Our Lady of Providence Seminary in 2001 to begin taking Philosophy classes. The following year, I was assigned to Immaculate Conception Seminary in New Jersey for my studies in Theology. By God's grace, I was ordained a priest in 2006.

The first five years of my priesthood were spent at St. Augustine Church in Providence which was a wonderful experience. I was certainly excited when Bishop Tobin asked me to take on two part-time assignments as Assistant Vocations Director for the Diocese and Associate Pastor of St. Thomas More Parish. I am especially blessed that this is *not* just a summer assignment but I will be here year-round.

Be assured of my prayers for all of you and I ask you to please keep me in your prayers as well and to pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life.
