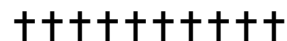

It is with great joy and anticipation (and a tad of anxiety) that I announce the signing of the contract with Mill City Construction to restore and renew St. Thomas More Church. The project will commence on August 4th (the Feast of St. John Vianney) and last for about three months.

The first part of the project will be to demolish and repair the part of the roof that has leaks where the parish hall meets the church and to re-pitch the roof. Next, the roof will be replaced on the rectory, parish hall and church. Lastly, the shingles on the church will be replaced with red-dipped cedar shingles matching that of St. Veronica Chapel and restoring the look of our building to its prior history. The window casings and trim will be replaced and the entrances of the church will receive new lighting that will be more efficient and also have a more classical look.

The project will not affect the interior of our beautiful building in any way but we will have to practice patience with the noise and regular challenges in a major maintenance project.

Our major fundraising campaign is almost ready to be launched and details are being finalized. In the meantime, we will use our savings to fund the initial part of the project as we move into our fundraising for St. Thomas More and additional enhancements to St. Veronica Chapel.

Please keep this endeavor and our efforts in your prayers as we enter into a truly significant moment in the life and history of our great parish! Special thanks to all on the building committee who have worked so hard to get us to this moment! I will keep you posted as we move along!
