***Remember, Restore, Renew Update***

The crews have begun in earnest to strip and re-build the roof over the hallway to the parish hall. Regrettably the recent rains came and invaded the building over last weekend but things have gotten cleaned up. The roofs on the rectory and parish hall have/are being stripped and the shingles on the side of St. Thomas More church have begun to be removed.

I spoke at all masses two weeks ago at St. Thomas More and last weekend at St. Veronica. It is possible you missed the brief presentation at the end of mass if you were at the other church or were away. All parishioners were mailed a color brochure with pledge form and online Faith Direct forms included. As I write this (Tuesday) the vast majority of homes have not yet received the third-class mailing. Pledge forms are located at entrances of the churches as well as the campaign board with pictures of the old and new church.

Thank-you to parishioners who hosted and helped by attending socials in last few weeks. We are hoping that all the mailed materials will arrive at your home any day now and that all will take time to read, pray and consider a pledge/donation for this critical maintenance project. It is the hope that by Labor Day Weekend all will have discerned their gift so we might have some idea how much we may need to borrow in order to complete the project prior to collecting pledges. I would encourage you to drive by St. Thomas More if you are not a regular there to see the challenges and the progress for yourself! Of course our beautiful church remains unlocked daily to facilitate visits to the Blessed Sacrament.

The entire project (without significant weather delays) is anticipated to go through November 4<sup>th</sup> or so. Please keep the men who are working on our site in your prayers for safety and their intentions.
