**Why doesn't Last Call Mass continue longer?** Well, with six normal weekend liturgies all year and Confirmation classes moving to Sunday evening, not to mention the cold nights and the Patriots, I don't think as many people would come. It is a nudge to pray for vocations too!

**How is the Remember, Restore, Renew Campaign going?** So far so good! Although the first mailing was delayed/lost which set back our timetable a bit we are on target for our "Commitment Weekend" on September 25-26<sup>th</sup> where we hope to know most peoples ability to help so we can budget our payments and borrowing accordingly.

**Read any good books lately?** Well, a little gem that was recommended that made me think called, "Oscar and the Lady in Pink" by Eric Emmanuel Schmitt. (Atlantic Books). A small book about a small boy with cancer. One you will remember that reveals God's providence in our crosses.

**Did you get a haircut Father?** Well, Yes! Not often enough but an indulgence I gladly receive when the Lord grants it!

**Do you prefer being our Pastor or Chaplain at Hendricken? How is it different?** I love both. I think it is like having two children that are very different. You love them both equally and magnanimously and see their differences as part of God's opening your heart to another experience of the same love.
