Of Grace and Graces.....

This past Tuesday something very special happened in our parish family. Bishop Tobin came to visit Old Pine Road to celebrate Grace Reddington's Confirmation and First Eucharist in the home of the Reddington Family, who have organized the annual *Race for Grace* event that many of us have participated in. As you can imagine this was an overwhelmingly moving liturgy and Mass. Grace was confirmed in her bed by Bishop Tobin and then walked forward with her parents to become a "tabernacle of the Lord".

Her brothers delivered the readings at the Mass and there was a young Justin who played some sacred pieces on the violin. All this was so special as Grace was given the name "Mary". Her sponsor was none other than Jack Dignan who is the young man whose Army unit we have adopted in Afghanistan. Of course he was away in combat so his mother Trish stood in as his proxy.

This occasion made me reflect on many things but most especially about the "grace" of the sacraments. The Church has always believed that the sacraments are celebrated in the Church community that traditionally prays for and provides for all her members especially those that do not fully yet understand what the Lord is doing. We think of infant baptism as a model of this deep reality. It resonated again that the grace of the Holy Spirit is rampant in all the sacraments instituted by the Lord. Let us rejoice at this reality. For who of us knows and understands fully what is really happening at the sacrifice of the Mass or in the other sacraments? Yet, we know in faith it is the Lord who comes and who loves. Our entire parish should rejoice in the gift of faith given to Mary Reddington by the hands of our bishop.

The other graces I ponder were the tremendous graces poured out upon our parish with 25 persons who made a pilgrimage to Rome for Deacon George Nixon's ordination. Visiting the bones of St. Peter beneath the Basilica, attending the Papal Audience and sharing in the tremendous promise and encouragement of priestly life in the Church in America were amazing. I hope you can hear of the stories of grace from the parishioners who went. I offered Mass for our parish and your intentions twice, once at the body of St. Phillip Neri last Monday and on Saturday evening at the Holy Spirit Church dedicated to the Divine Mercy and St. Faustina just near the Vatican. Our Church is so rich in faith, love and devotion. I know we all prayed for our parish throughout our journey and could feel the effects of your prayers for us.
