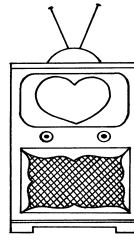
FOOD COLLECTION

As I am sure you are aware by now Pope Benedict has named Msgr. Robert Evans the new auxiliary bishop of Providence. He is currently the Pastor of St. Phillip in Smithfield and the Pastor of our very own Fr. Jeremy Rodrigues. Bishop Elect Evans was born in 1947 and grew up in Providence. His mother lives in North Providence. He attended Our Lady of Providence High School and graduated from Our Lady of Providence College Seminary in 1969. He studied in Rome at the North American College and attended the Gregorian and Angelicum Universities.

He has served in numerous ministries and parishes around the state of RI, from Westerly to Bristol to Providence.

He returned to Rome to complete further studies in Canon Law and also was in charge of the Ongoing Formation of Priests Sabbatical Program in Rome as well as other diocesan assignments here in the Diocese of Providence. He also served at the Apostolic Nunciature from 2005 to 2007.

Bishop Elect Evans will help and assist Bishop Tobin in whatever ways the Bishop will need his ministry. I can assure you that Bishop Elect Evans has been a wonderful priest. He is renowned for being gracious, prayerful and steadily kind and generous. Our Holy Father has given us all a great gift. Most diocesan priests were gathered all together at the Priests Convocation when it was announced which was a particular grace for him and the many priests present. Among them were Msgr. Halloran, Fr. Henry and myself. We all celebrated Mass once the announcement was made.

Please pray for Bishop Elect Evans in this time of preparation prior to his ordination. I am sure we will be blessed by his ministry and hopefully he will visit our parish in the near future in some capacity.
