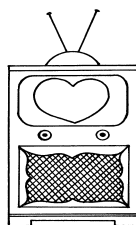

All Saints – All Souls- All Aboard!

As the leaves turn colors and begin to fall we are reminded of the transitions and change all of our lives experience. There is none more dramatic, important or challenging than that of the passing of a loved one. This year All Saints Day falls on a Sunday allowing us all to celebrate this great feast together as a parish family (all while not having to attend Mass again during the week for the holy day).

All Saints Day is the occasion for the faithful to recall the many who enjoy the “beatific vision” and are in the full presence of God. We remember not just the famous saints with whom many of us enjoy personal spiritual friendship but all the saints. There are so many who do not have images, statues or windows in their names but are indeed in full communion with God and interceding for us. It is the church’s belief that the communion of saints is present at each Mass, even a quiet daily Mass – what a reality! Let us invoke the saints and praise God for their example, communion with God and intercession for us.

All Souls Day follows on November 2nd. This more somber but just as solemn day is where we pray for all our dead. Here the Church asks all the faithful to pray for those who died with “lesser faults” and the temporal effects of sin. They are purified before they enter into the full presence of God. This day and practice includes the belief in two realities. First, that all believers are purified before entering heaven and second, that the prayers and masses offered for the dead really can and do assist them. I know that many Protestants and even some Catholics no longer believe in the doctrine of purgatory. Some erroneously think it diminishes the salvation won for us by Christ and others, because of exaggerated abuses tied to indulgences and the like, have dismissed it. I also believe that our modern culture often denies death. Cemeteries in our country are some of the least-visited places in our neighborhoods unlike most cultures in the world. It is highly popular to proclaim everyone in heaven at death and to simply celebrate that. While, of course, Christ may deem so many to enter through the narrow door I know our Church’s teaching is rich in the notion of communion, intercessory prayer and biblical foundation (See Maccabees 12:41-42, 2 Timothy 1:18, 1 cor 3:15) To pray for the dead is to give them the Lord’s love and our own.

We will celebrate our annual Mass of Remembrance on All Souls Day at 7:00pm this Monday evening. All are welcome. I will celebrate three Masses that day as is proscribed by the Church for all our dead. Why not pray for all the dead on Monday, perhaps stop by the grave of a loved one or offer an extra prayer for them? These days are gifts for the saints and souls everywhere. Let our own mortality remind us of our gift of life and our invitation to remain united to those who sleep in death awaiting the resurrection!
