Thanks to Our Lady's Guild for hosting the Mass of Remembrance reception last week. This is always a moving and emotional evening of consolation for those who have lost loved ones this past year.

One of the boiler pumps at St. Thomas More gave out this week. It will be replaced at the small cost of \$2000.00. In addition, the humidifier that maintains the organ pipes has also departed and will have to be replaced.

Painting of the interior of St. Veronica Chapel should happen before the holidays come. We are aware of the markings and inconsistencies in the walls. Just trying to make sure we get everything just right.

Some outdoor landscaping at St Thomas More has also been ordered to help complement the new restoration. The work should be completed soon we hope.
