This past Sunday evening several parishioners responded to the invitation to come and brainstorm ideas about the upcoming diocesan "Evangelization Program" that will go full force in December. Some ideas included placing a sign near our outdoor manger that will read, "Come Home for Christmas" at St. Veronica. It was suggested that we include evangelization efforts on the parish website and explore a mass mailing to all homes within our parish boundaries inviting all to consider the Catholic faith.

There was a great desire to introduce adult catechesis opportunities for already practicing Catholics and a series of topics was proposed. They included: annulments/divorce, sexuality/chastity, confession/reconciliation, faith and works, Satan/evil/exorcisms, redemptive suffering, the Real Presence, the Bible, heaven/hell/purgatory, death & dying/cremation, God's will v. man's will, post-abortion healing, prayer and devotion to Mary and the saints.

We thought it good to start with a presentation entitled, "Why be Catholic...Do Denominations Matter?" I will lead this talk followed by Q & A on November 15th from 6-7pm at St. Thomas More Parish Hall. All are welcome, practicing and the lapsed. Hopefully you can make it.

We will introduce more of these topics in the new year and publish a schedule soon. If you have any other suggestions or ideas please send them along. Our region will sponsor a meeting for those interested in the evangelization project on Thursday, November 12th at 7:00pm at St. Francis in Wakefield. Our committee members plan to attend and this is open to all.

There is also a praise and worship night scheduled for Tuesday, November 17th at St. Veronica Chapel initiated by parishioners...you are welcome to come or even just stop by. Our parish kicked off a youth group last week and 18 high schoolers showed up to brainstorm and make plans. More will come out soon. Many thanks to Our Lady's Guild and all who helped make our All Souls Day masses and receptions so prayerful and hospitable! Our ministry fairs will take place on the weekend of November 22nd. Please plan to drop in to see what is happening and the varied possibilities of getting involved in a new ministry.
