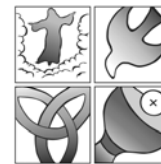

This past Sunday evening we had our first organizational meeting for our new 18 (!) young missionaries who will go for the first time to the Dominican Republic to the Mustard Seed Orphanage. We filled out some medical forms, passports are in the making and our requests for your prayer support starts now! Please pray for the orphans and their caregivers our own missionaries. They are a mix of young men and women from sophomore and junior classes from public and Catholic schools. Admittedly, Mr. Crawford and I are not as anxious as we were last year since we have some idea of what will happen yet there remains excitement and newness to a different experience with different missionaries and even some new children at Mustard Seed.

Please know we are relying on your prayerful support, encouragement and financial generosity for our endeavors. We have scheduled a wreath sale weekend in December, a second collection and are exploring other ways in which we can raise the monies needed. Each flight costs \$1000.00 since we are going to a resort country during school break and we are asked to donate \$820.00 for each missionary part of which covers our food and lodging and for the large part is a donation to the orphanage itself. We are all writing letters and launching internet fundraising to raise a portion of it....the rest will come from our parish endeavors. Last year a few couples in our parish gave up their Christmas gifts to each other to instead support a missionary on their trip. Anyone who has creative ideas or ways we can reach our goal is encouraged to give us a call!
